Analysers are Thinkers - great with facts and numbers. They are well-organised, they work hard to get the correct answer and they pay attention to details.

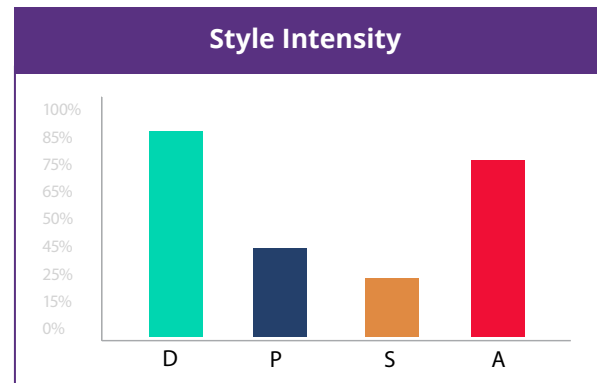

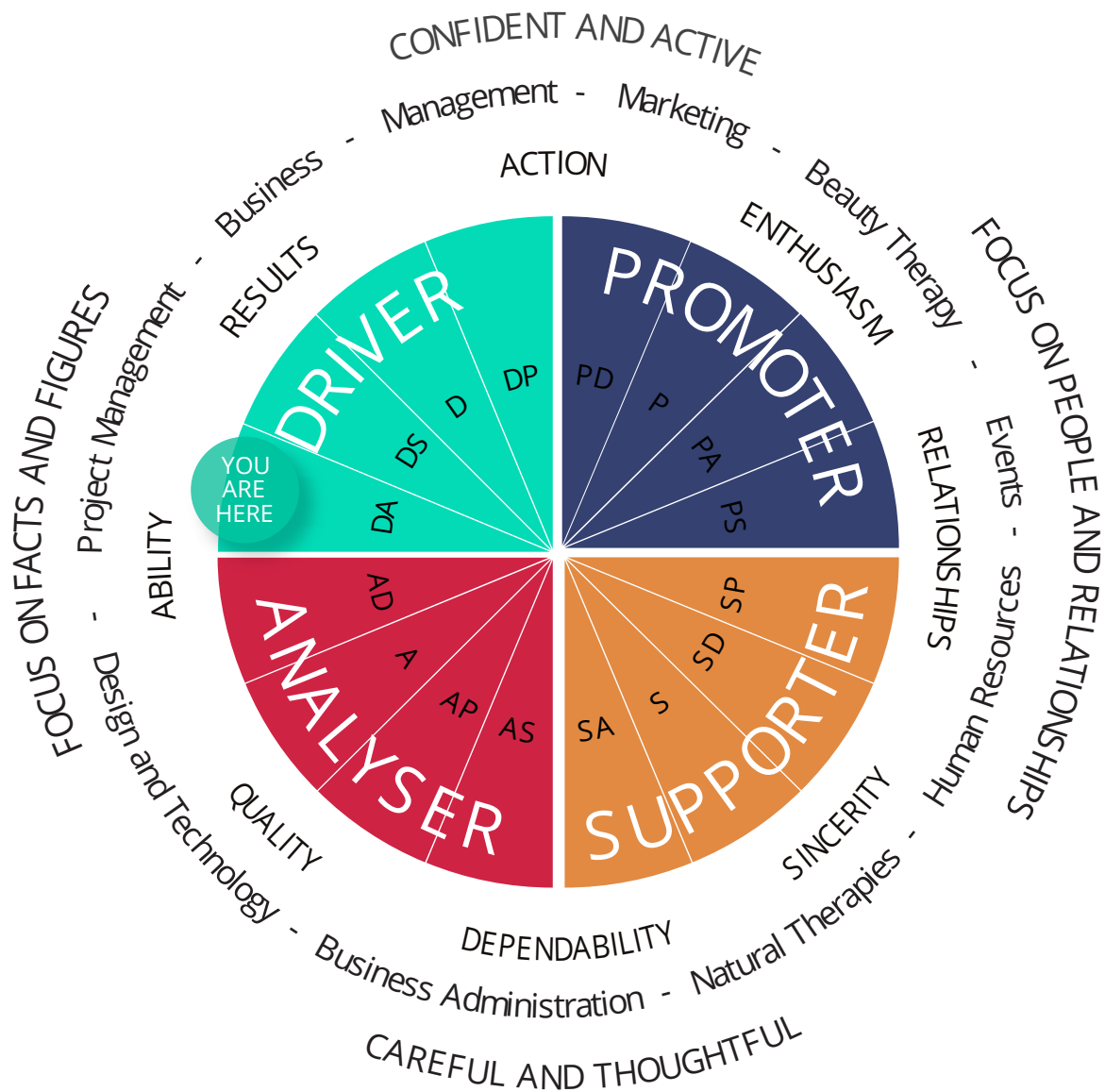
People are a blend of all four styles and each style has its own level of strength. This graph indicates how strongly each style influences your personality.

Understanding your career personality map:

The Map is divided into the four Career Profile styles, **DRIVER** | **PROMOTER** | **SUPPORTER** | **ANALYSER** | and combinations of each style (DA—Driver + Analyser, DP—Driver + Promoter, DS—Driver + Supporter, etc.). Your style is marked as 'YOU ARE HERE'. The outer circle shows 'what you focus on' and 'how you act'. For instance, a Driver focuses on facts and numbers and is confident and active; a Supporter focuses on people and relationships and is careful and thoughtful. The middle circle shows examples of careers that match your strengths. The inner circle represents 'what's important to you' - for Drivers it's results and for Promoters it's enthusiasm.
